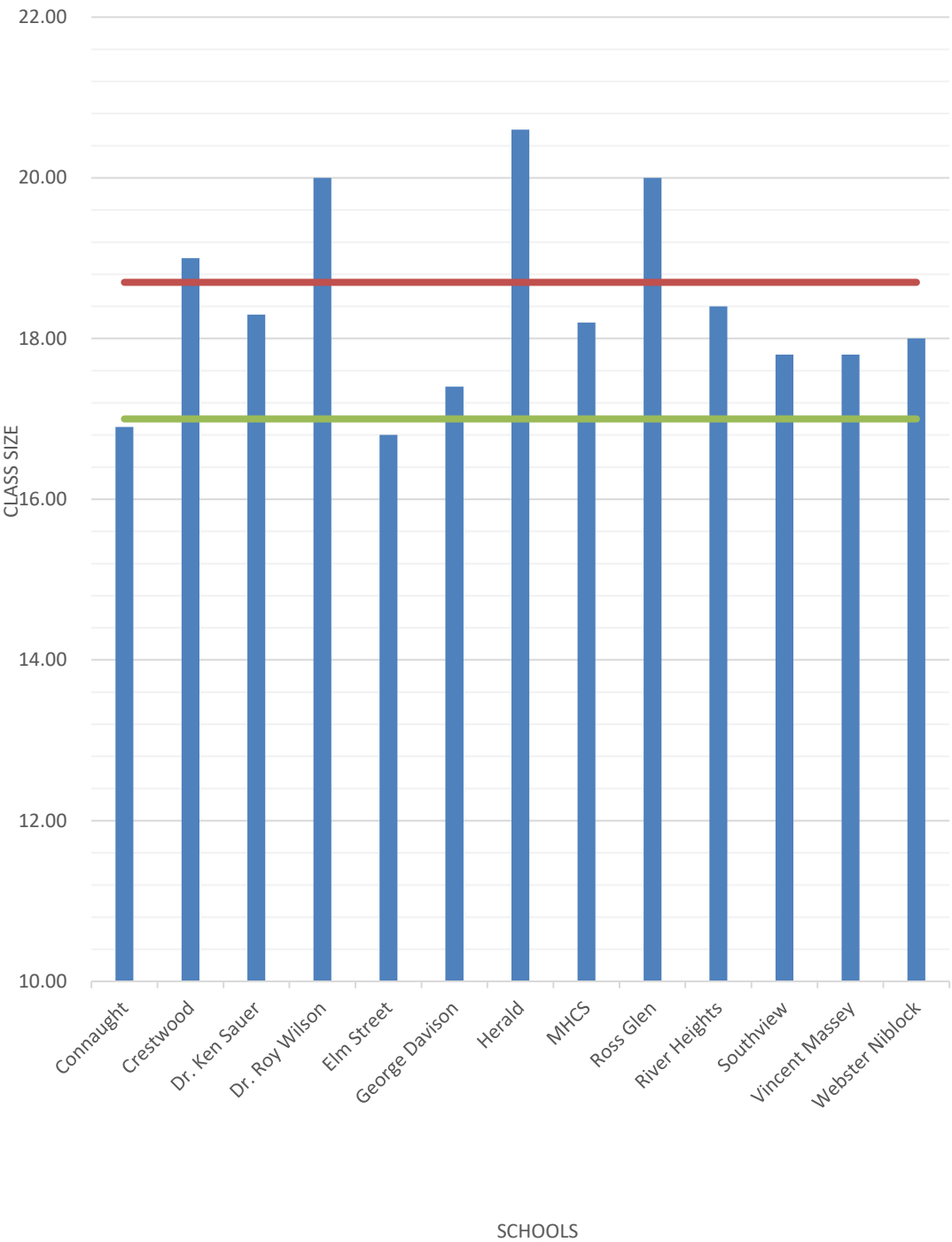

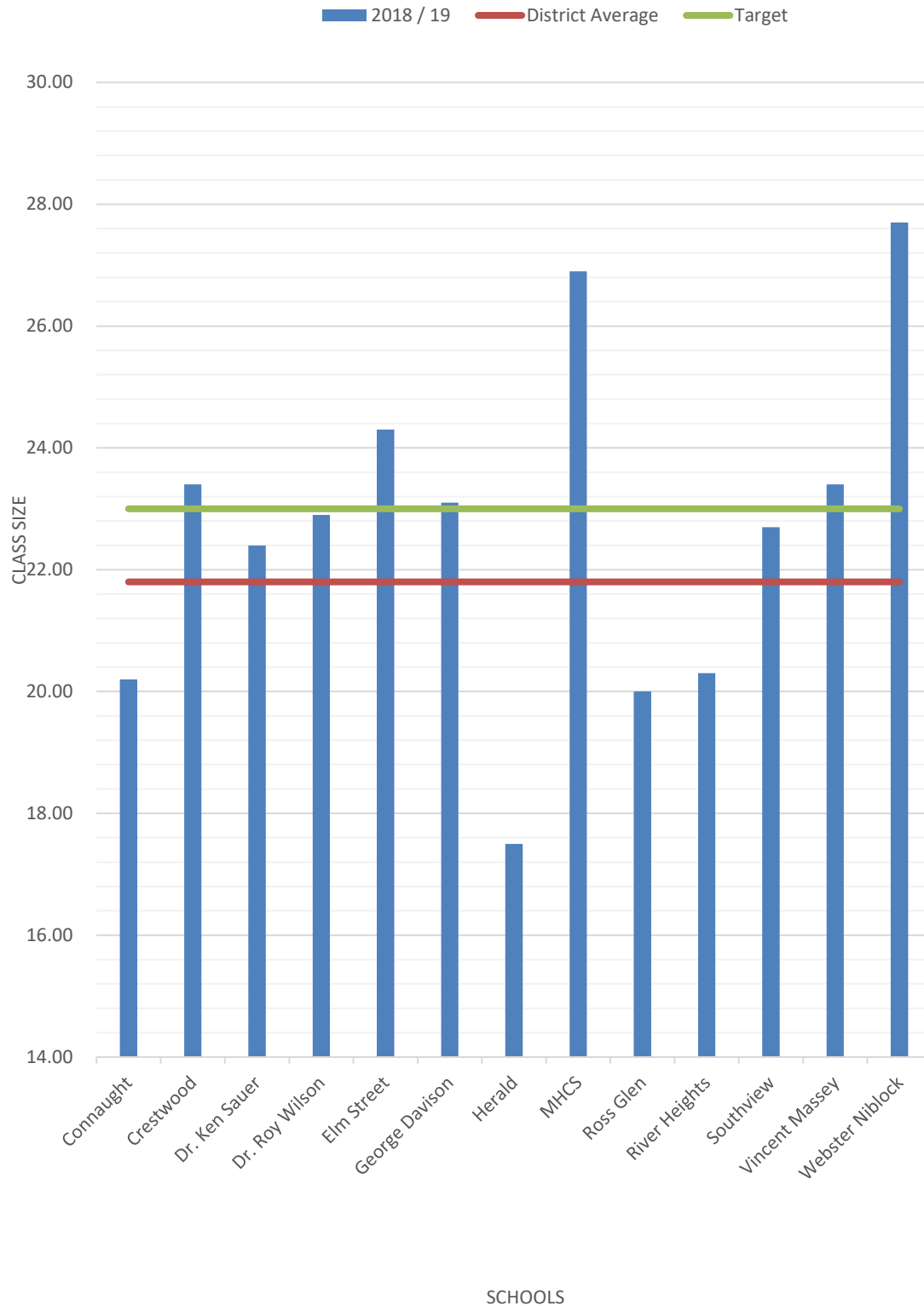

2018 / 19 District Average Target

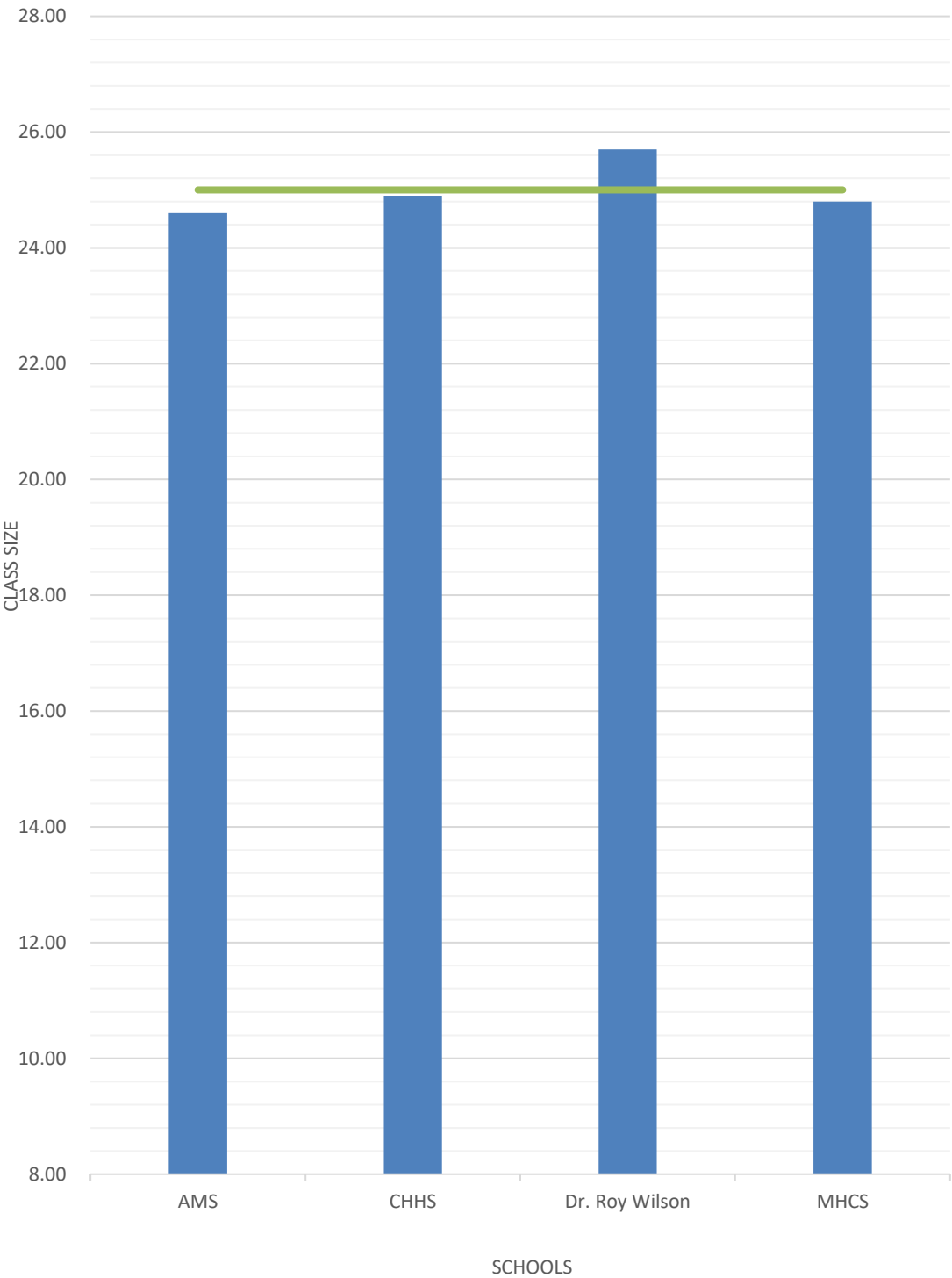


4 to 6 Class Size - 2018/19



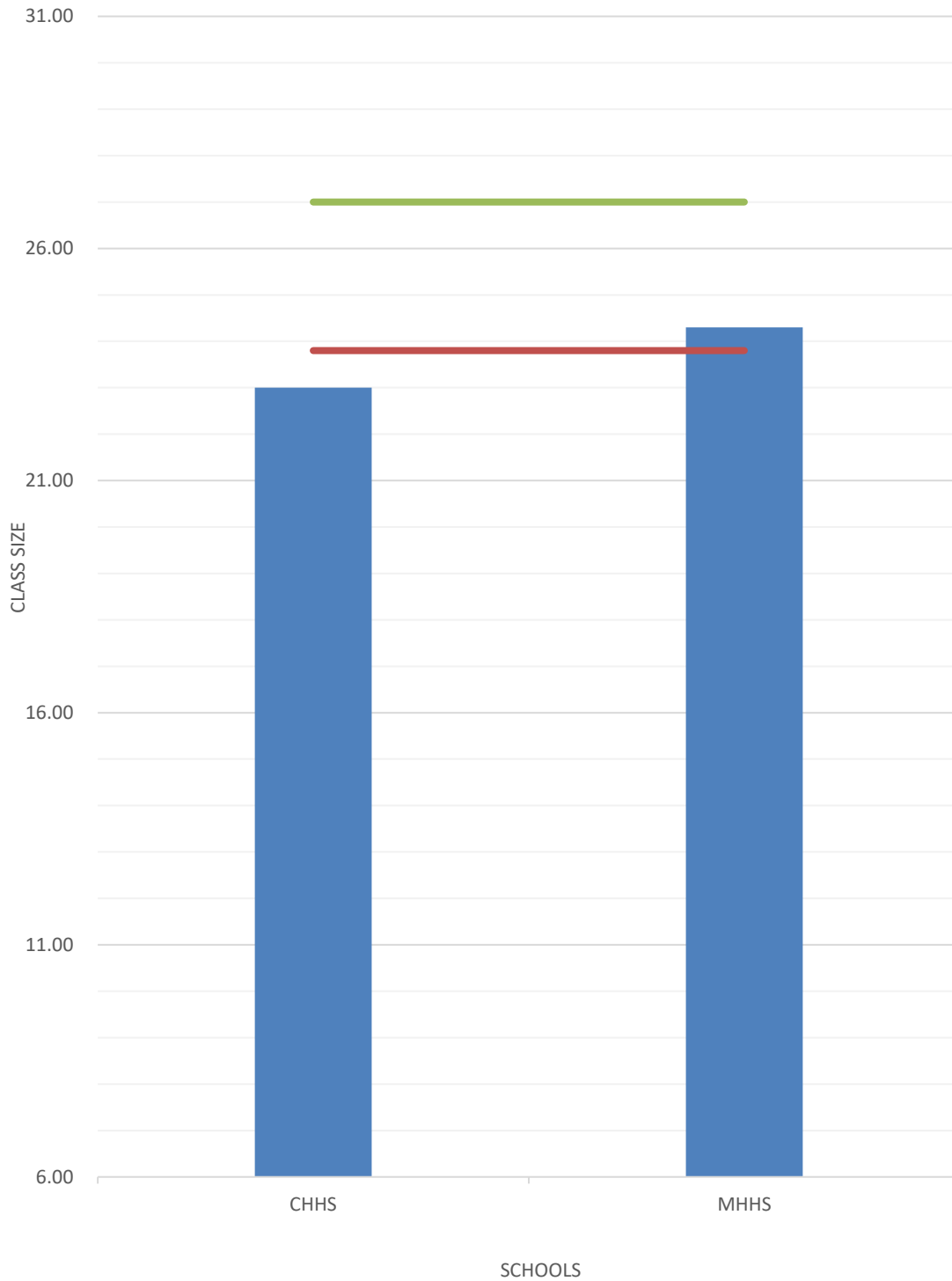
7 to 9 Class Size - 2018/19
