PRESENTATION

Constable Brent Bohrn, School Resource Officer (SRO) at Crescent Heights High School (CHHS) presented on online safety. The Medicine Hat Police Service runs a program called Encouraging Positive Informed Choices (EPIC) which aims to create positive connections with police at an early age, presenting facts on a variety of topics; most importantly encouraging leadership and making informed choices.

Constable Bohrn reported that most issues he sees as an SRO are about internet safety, such as sharing inappropriate images and social media cyber bullying. The EPIC - Digital Citizenship program is presented to all grade 7-9 students, however it is also important that parents understand the risks so we can work together to stay safe.
