- Celebrations to be had in every category
- Recognizing the work of schools in:
  - Supporting a model of response and the connected processes
  - Working alongside OLC Team to impact instruction
  - Delivering on commitments to students and families
- Celebrating the "n"!
  - Maintained our level of participation
  - Nearing a 3 year average of 3000 respondents
  - Increased participation (2200 → 2800 → 3061 → 3034)



### Closer Examination Required...



- Lag Data Categories
  - Some interesting data in completion and participation rates
  - Our 6<sup>th</sup> year data suggests that we are approaching provincial norms, but a year or so behind the average
  - Lower Diploma scores in current year, but increases in Excellence and 3 year average indicates a positive trend
- The Unknowns created by Covid:
  - Would we have continued gains in PAT/Dip data?
  - Would we have continued or maintained gains in excellence?
  - How will we sort through data post Covid?
- What are schools noticing?
