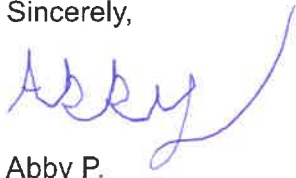

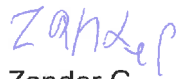
Dear Mr. Davidson,

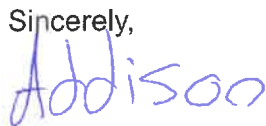
Dear Mr, Davidson,
