Copyright and Fair Dealing Reference Materials

The fair dealing provision in Canada's copyright law permits teachers to copy and communicate short excerpts from copyright-protected works provided the dealing is "fair." The Fair Dealing Guidelines describe what is fair. These guidelines must be followed to prevent copyright infringement.
