



BYLAW NO. 2020-01

BEING A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH ELECTORAL BOUNDARIES FOR TRUSTEE GENERAL ELECTION

Pursuant to the provisions in the *Education Act, Statutes of Alberta, 2012* and *Local Authorities Election Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000*, and the amendments thereto, The Medicine Hat Public Board of Education, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 In accordance with *Section 76* of the *Education Act*, The Medicine Hat Public Board of Education declares that:

- (a) there shall be five (5) trustee positions, and
- (b) the election will be by general vote of the electors within the boundaries of the Medicine Hat Public Board of Education, which are described below:

Township 12, Range 5, West of the 4th Meridian

Sections 7 to 9 inclusive; Sections 16 to 21 inclusive; Sections 28 to 33 inclusive; That portion of Section 22 lying within the City of Medicine Hat.

Township 12, Range 6, West of the 4th Meridian

Sections 11 to 14 inclusive; Sections 23 to 28 inclusive; Sections 32 to 36 inclusive; East half of Section 15; North half and Southeast quarter of Section 22.

Township 13, Range 5, West of the 4th Meridian

Sections 4 to 9 inclusive; Those portions of Sections 16, 17, and 21 lying West of the South Saskatchewan River; Those portions of Sections 18 and 20 lying South of the South Saskatchewan River; That portion of the Northwest quarter of Section 19 lying West of the South Saskatchewan River; That portion of the South half of Section 19 lying

South of the South Saskatchewan River and that portion of the Southwest quarter of Section 30 lying West of the South Saskatchewan River.

Township 13, Range 61 West of the 4th Meridian

Sections 1 to 3 inclusive; Sections 10 to 15 inclusive; Sections 22 and 23; East half of Section 4; South halves of Sections 26 and 27; Those portions of the Southwest quarter of

Section 4 and the South half of Section 5 lying South of the South Saskatchewan River; That portion of Section 24 lying West of the South Saskatchewan River and that portion of the South half of Section 25 lying of the South Saskatchewan River.

2 This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the date of the passing of the third and final reading.

Board Procedures Regulation – AR 82/2019:

- 6 (1) Every bylaw of a board must have 3 distinct separate readings before the bylaw is passed.
- (2) Not more than 2 readings of a bylaw must be given at any 1 meeting unless the trustees present at the meeting unanimously agree to give the bylaw a 3rd reading.
 - (3) The first reading of a bylaw must be in full and, if each board member has in the member's possession a written, printed or electronic copy of the bylaw, the 2nd and 3rd readings may be by title and description only.
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
