1. Alternative Learning Team (ALT)

The ALT offers services that target complex communication, specialized programming, behaviour emotional support for students and professional capacity building for staff. With three teachers, an educational assistant and an occupational therapist, the team shares the belief that educational practices should be flexible and responsive to the strengths, needs, and learning preferences of individuals and the school community as a whole. Classrooms across Alberta are becoming more complex, students arrive with greater needs than they did in the past. Always committed to meeting people where they are at, this team plays a critical role in supporting the mental health needs of our MHPSD family.

Their approach is kind, supportive and paced appropriately for each unique situation, always focused on building relationship first. Making people feel seen, heard and valued is paramount to their success. Regulation is the foundation of addressing complex behaviour, with education on best practices layered throughout. We want to help people understand the science behind this work, starting with the brain, layered with regulation strategies, wrapped together with an individual support plan and sensory plan. They proudly honour student voice as a critical component of their work.


