PROCEDURES

- A. The district will, within available resources:
 - 1. Screen students for early identification of special needs.
 - 2. Refer students "at risk" for learning problems and those identified as having special needs for further consultation and/or assessment.
 - 3. Utilize qualified persons in early identification of students where a special education program is necessary.
 - 4. Consult with parents and, where appropriate, the student before providing a special education program.
 - 5. Provide access to a special education program for identified students.
 - 6. Provide special education programs:
 - a) based on an Individualized Program Plan (IPP) which specifies goals and objectives and outlines services to meet the identified educational needs of the individual student with special needs
 - b) located in a variety of settings, including the regular classroom
 - c) based on and modified by the results of continuous assessment evaluation
 - d) based on instruction appropriate to the student's individual learning level
 - 7. Provide ongoing communication regarding coordination of services.
 - 8. Make written procedures available regarding the provision of health-related support services for students with special needs. (Refer to Policy 370)

- 9. Coordinate transitions for special needs students.
- 10. Utilize School Teams to coordinate programs for special needs students.
- 11. Provide a process for equitable and fair dispute resolution and appeals.
- B. The district will allocate resources to assess special needs students and to provide for the appropriate professional development for staff regarding special needs students and their programs.
- C. Procedures for the following areas will be outlined in the Special Education Handbook.
 - 1. Screening
 - 2. Referrals
 - 3. Assessments
 - 4. Program Planning
 - 5. Program Placement
 - 6. Special Education Appeals [Policy 370]
