2. Provincial Budget Update

A summary was presented of the Provincial Budget and the impact on the School Division.

Provincially \$700M has been added to the education budget. Divisionally we will see an increase of 1% to both Base Grants and Operations and Maintenance. Transportation will also see an increase of 4.6%. However, due to our declining enrollment, and Hold Harmless funding it is unlikely the Division will receive a net increase in funding.

Additional funding has been designated to support professional learning and resources for the new curriculum, as well as for student well-being. Specific information is not yet available, more information will follow.
