PROCEDURE

- 1. Early notification is necessary for the development and implementation of effective intervention. The teacher will inform the school administrator, or designate, and the parents/guardians at the first indication that the student is having difficulty.
- 2. When initial interventions have not been successful and a student is deemed to require targeted or specialized supports, a learning plan will be developed for that student. A learning plan may be a Learner Profile, Inclusive Education Planning Tool, or Individualized Program Plan. A copy of the completed Learning Plan will be placed in the Student Record. Schools may access the services of appropriate Division personnel to support this planning.
- 3. Student placement and promotion decisions, except specialized placement decisions, are made by the school principal, or designate, in consultation with the student's parents/guardians or the independent student and staff. Consideration of the whole student, such as: age, achievement, general ability, and social/emotional development will be taken into account.
- 4. Specialized placements will be approved by the Associate Superintendent: Student Services.
- 5. A written record of student achievement, progress and promotion decisions will be maintained and forwarded to the receiving teacher/school whenever students are promoted. Schools may choose to promote a student who has not achieved the established standards of achievement or performance because this is deemed to be in the best interest of the student.

- 6. Whenever a student is not promoted to the next grade level (K-8) the principal will forward a copy of the Learning Plan or Student Progress Plan to the Associate Superintendent: Student Services by the first week of July.
- 7. Appeals regarding student placement shall be in accordance with Policy 618 Appeals and Hearings Regarding Student Matters.
