The theme of Emma's presentation is to encourage students to expand their boundaries and say yes to positive opportunities. Emma strongly believes that through passion, drive and determination, there is no limit to what people can achieve. Emma also touches on her struggles with anxiety and the pressure of coming from a small tow, advocating that regardless of where a person comes from and what their limitations may be, their dreams are always within reach.
