Ringette Multi-Sports Performance

The Ringette Multi-Sports Performance program would be designed for those girls who have a strong interest and desire to learn and improve their ringette skills. The program will also be focusing on fitness and nutrition throughout the year. Students in the Ringette program will be participating in various sports to help enhance their skill level.

Students will be utilizing various facilities during the year. The on-ice instruction will be held at the Hockey Hounds Rec Centre and the dryland training and fitness component will be done at CHHS. The students will also be involved in a number of activities using the CHHS gym and field. We will also be using the Family Leisure Centre and the Fieldhouse for certain activities.

Timeline: Grades 7-8

Ice Sessions

Ice sessions will take place at the Hockey Hounds Rec Centre with ice times being about 60 - 70 minutes in length. The rink is located 1 block away from the school allowing us to get there quickly and busses will not be needed to transport athletes. All on-ice instruction will be done by a

teacher who has had coaching experience in Ringette. Teacher/coaches will be expected to go to additional Ringette workshops to enhance their coaching ability.

Athletes will store their equipment in the basement of the Hockey Hounds Rec Centre during the ice sessions. Parents will be able to drop off and pick up equipment on the ice session days. An adult will be there to ensure all equipment is stored and locked up properly. There will also be an adult available at set times during the afternoon to allow for equipment pickup from the rink. The storage facility will be locked up at all times when not in use.

Sports Performance - Ringette fees

The fee structure has been set so that families can pay monthly or one full payment. Cost to the athlete will be \$50.00 per month or \$450.00 for the entire school year.

In doing a quick fee comparison with other programs like this one I found that with the location of our school our costs our considerably cheaper. Monthly fees ranged from \$100 to \$750 per month over 10 months or \$1000 to \$7500/year.
