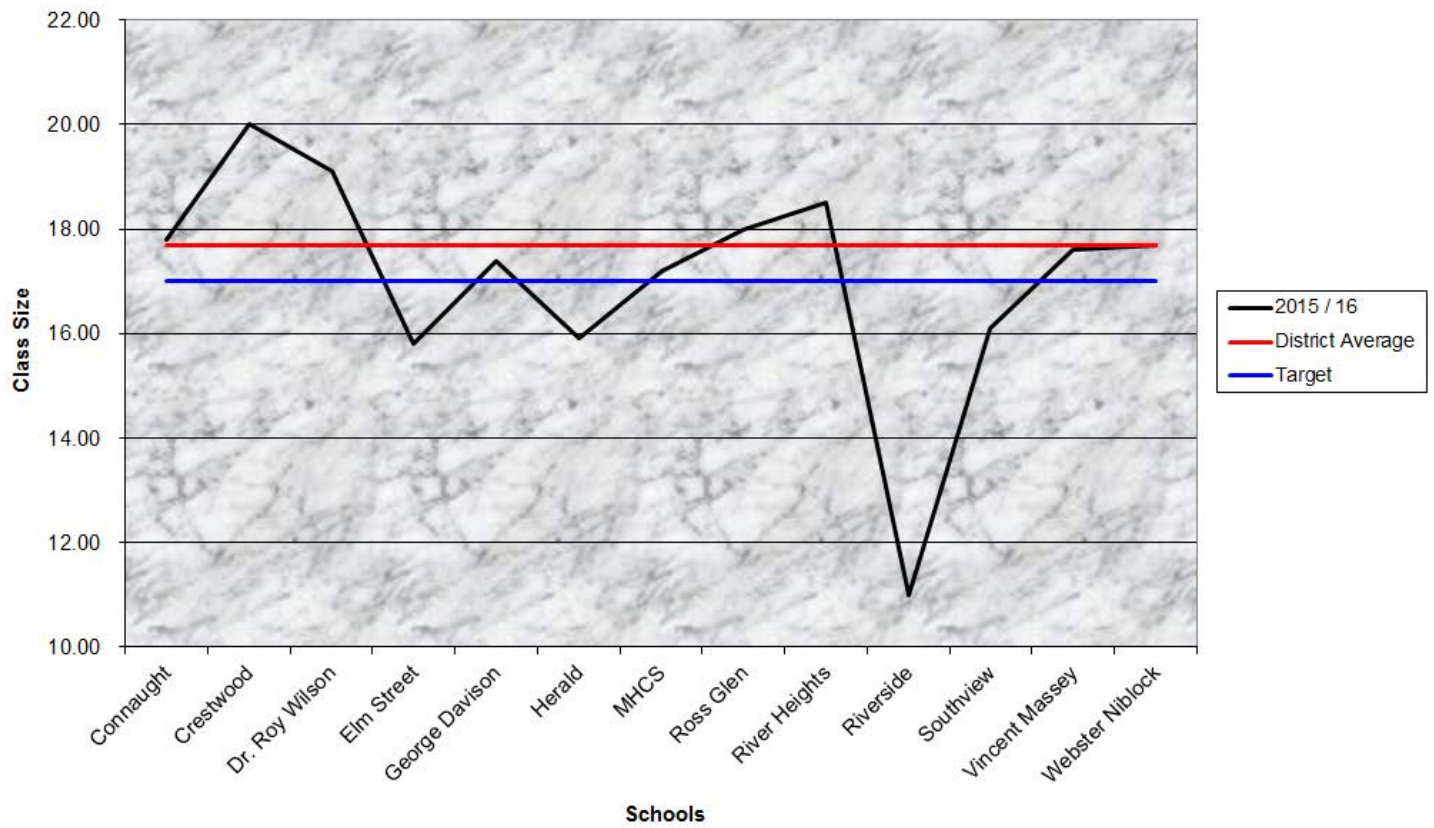

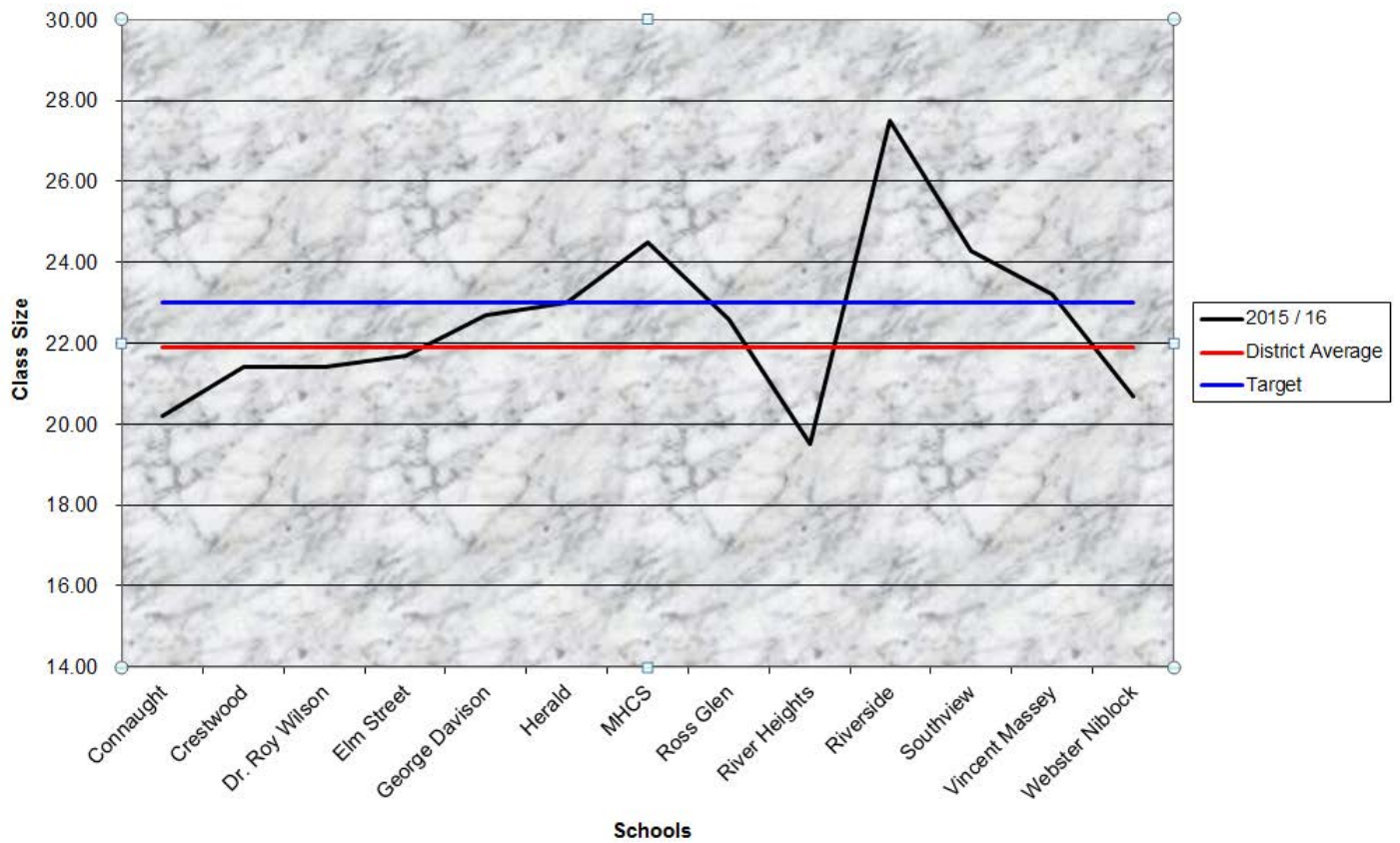

K to 3 Class Size - 2015/16



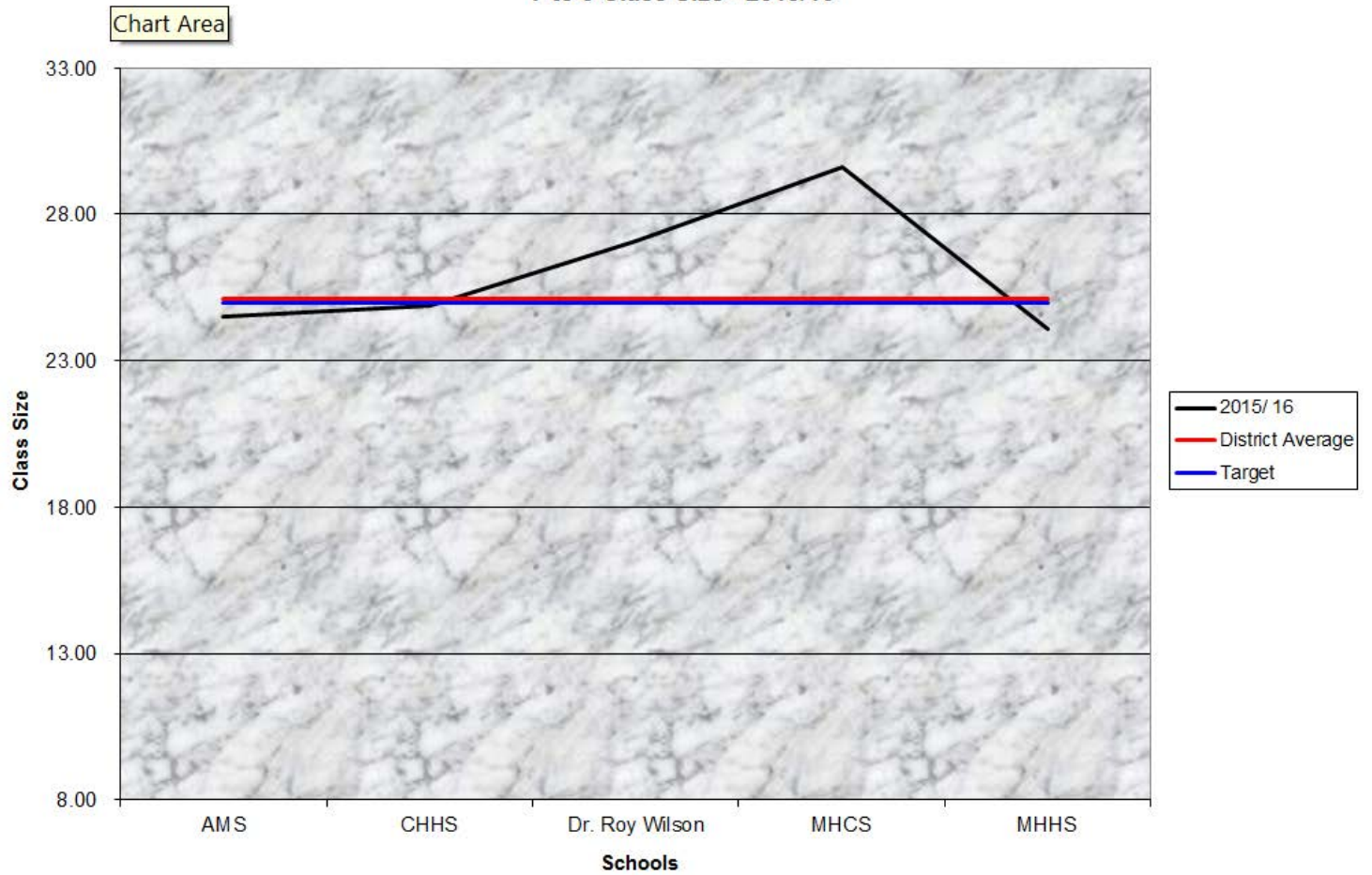

4 to 6 Class Size - 2015/16



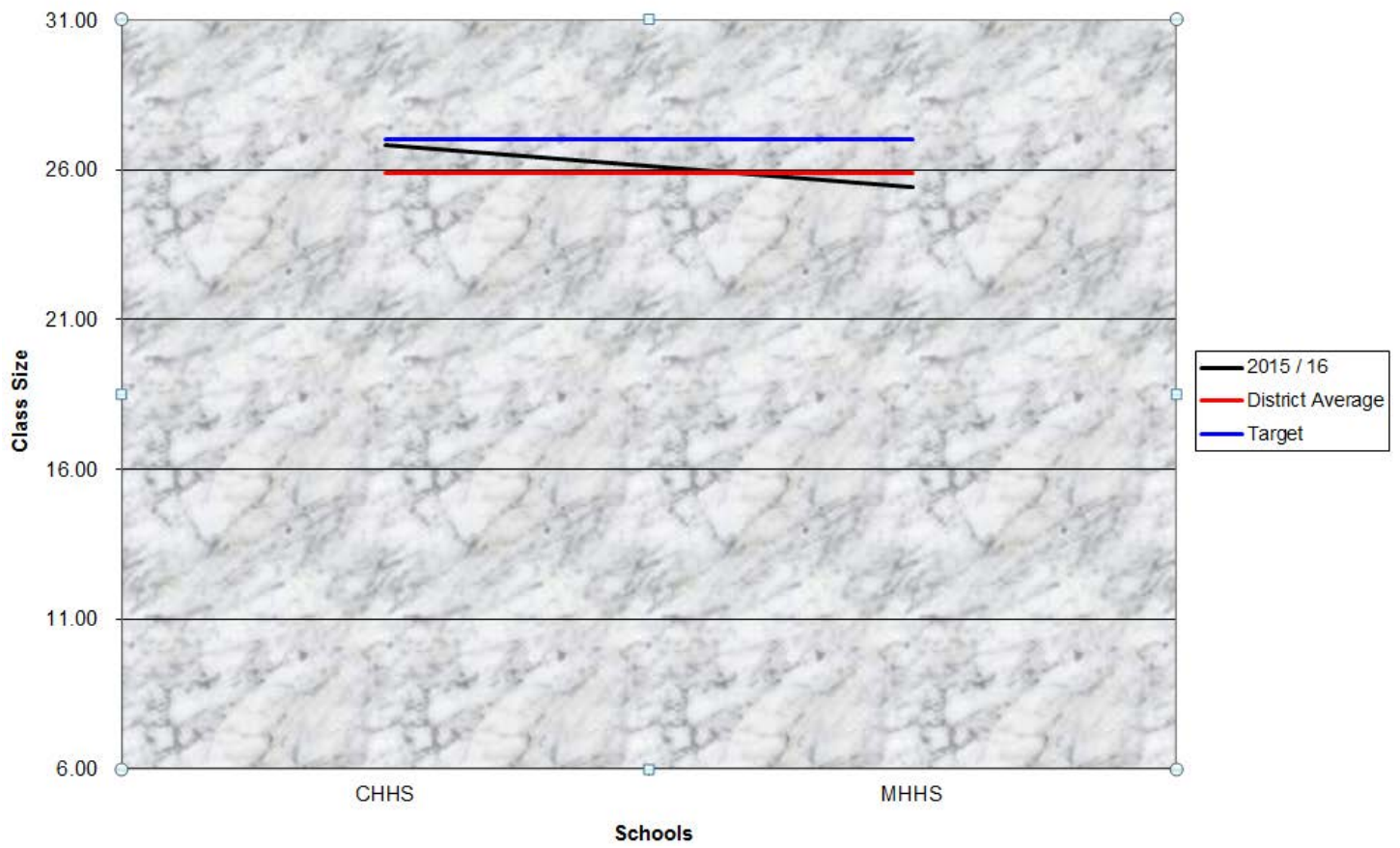
