



Overview of the Work

New Curriculum

WHAT:

New curriculum for English Language Arts and Literature, Mathematics and Physical Education and Wellness were implemented beginning in the fall of 2022. Implementation will extend for division 2 teachers next fall.

WHO:

Spring 2022-Winter 2023 Support Grades K-3 (ELAL and Math) Grades K-6 (PEW) Spring 2023-Winter 2024 Support Grades 4-6 (ELAL and Math)

HOW:

12 division-led PL Days School-led PL with support Individual/Group Collaboration

Teacher Clarity

WHAT:

A method & mindset that focuses on clear expectations, instruction and assessment for students.

WHO:

Grades 7-12 All Middle/High Schools (Also a part of K-6 New Curriculum PL)

HOW:

Two division-led PL Days School-led PL with support Individual/Group Collaboration
