Theatre Arts Field Trip to London / Ireland 2016

On Sept 16, there was a Family for parents of students in the Theatre Arts program which determined the support to plan a trip to London and areas of Ireland. We discussed proposed trip details, risks involved in participation and related to the trip. CHHS has found great success with trips where students participate in workshops and perform. The proposed trip would occur the evening of March 22 to return on April 1, 2016. We will be staging the musical *"The Addams Family"* in February. We would like to take Theatre Arts students in grades 9 to 12. Students will receive training in performance skills, as well as attend West End productions and tours related to theatre. We will use our repertoire of musical theatre numbers to perform publicly.

There are several conditions that must be met for participation in the trip. Families must ensure that their child is able to legally enter the United Kingdom & Ireland and to leave Canada, as well as any requirements set by SD76 or CHHS Theatre Arts which must be met.

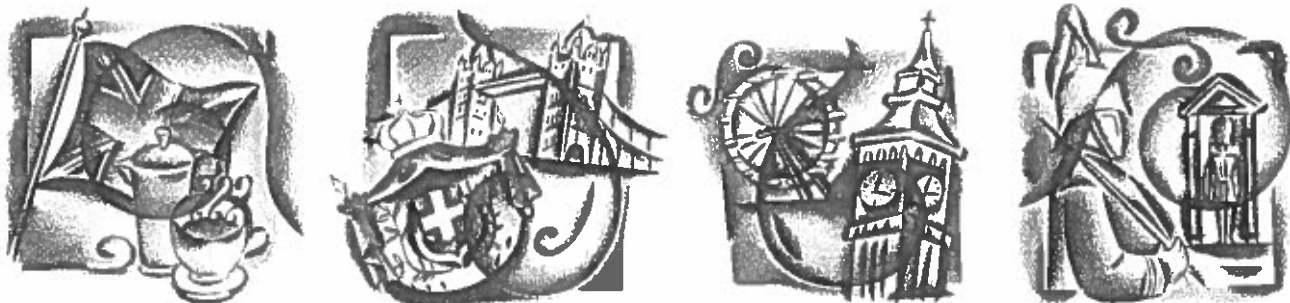
- Students must be in good standing in the *"Addams Family"* musical as a performer.
- Missed classes and rehearsals can and will result in removal from the trip.
- Passport, required travel documents, and SD 76 conditions must be met.
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There are opportunities to fundraise to reduce the final cost, but a student will only benefit from the work that his or her family contributes for fundraising. A parent group volunteers to chair the coordination of fundraising events. Some of the money generated from musical towards costs associated with the field trip. We are using the tour group STS Tours which is a Canadian based company out of Vancouver (<http://ststours.ca>). The projected cost for the trip is between \$3,300 - \$3,500. This amount can increase or decrease based on choices made for activities and meals.

There are 2 Teachers from SD76 who will be chaperoning this trip: Jennifer Davies and Pat Grisonich. A limited number of students and adults can participate on this trip. Families will pay for any passport fees, Visa application fees, insurance and any medical preparations such as vaccinations required for travel.

It is sincerely felt that through fundraising efforts, we can bring the cost down as we have successfully been able to accomplish this on previous years. There has been an impressive turnout from families; the parent group appears to be strong and willing to work on several projects to finance the trip. There is also a proven history from these same families working to support the drama program and our productions. We are very grateful to have these families and new families working with us and look forward to working with everyone to make this year fun and productive learning year.
