- Increasing the knowledge and understanding of FNMI history, Treaty and Aboriginal rights, lands, cultures and languages; and to provide referral services for FNMI students and families to appropriate agencies.
- Increasing and establishing community and family engagement opportunities.

In partnership with the Medicine Hat College, Miywasin Centre, MAWS (*Miywasin Aboriginal Women's Society*) and Metis Local 8, the Division is excited to present *Keskih Ke Mowin* (sharing our culture) event on May 11-14, 2020. The week-long event will create opportunities for students to experience different FNMI teachings and cultural traditions.
