# 2. Regional Collaborative Service Delivery

The RCSD is a regional model that supports schools and engages community partners in meeting the needs of children and youth through the school years. An update showing the continuum of services and service delivery model was shared.

The goals of RCSD are to improve access to supports and services, to build capacity of communities including school staff, service providers and families and to improve integration and coordination of supports and services.

Additionally, Mrs. Fedor shared an FAQ sheet created by the regional managers, answering many common questions regarding the Regional Collaborative Service Delivery.

The Region has received an additional \$400,000 in funding.
