The City of Medicine Hat has requested MHPSD participate in the City of Medicine Hat's voluntary water restrictions to reduce water usage because of the present water shortage and drought situation in Southern Alberta. As a result, MHPSD Facilities will be reducing our field watering by 25%, and all requests to turn on sprinklers for year-end fun days will not be granted. If the water shortage and drought situation improve then Facilities will re-evaluate this in conjunction with the City of Medicine Hat.
